

Executive Director's Report - 2024

Each year, the LLA provides its members with numerous opportunities for professional development, socializing, and community service.

In 2024 the LLA coordinated thirty committee meetings and offered twenty-two live CLE credits at its office. The association was actively represented at the Pennsylvania Bar Association's two House of Delegates meetings, the Conference of County Bar Leaders, and the Young Lawyers' Summit.

In addition to its Annual Banquet and Awards Ceremony, which was held at the Carraige House in Williamsport, the LLA organized several social events for its members. These events included a reception celebrating Law Day, a Yoga in the Park event, the Annual Picnic, a Little League World Series baseball game, and a reception after the New Attorney Admission Ceremony.
