ORDER

AND NOW, this 8th day of November 1999, this Order is entered upon the Court having received a motion for reconsideration filed *pro se* by the Defendant on October 26, 1999, requesting this Court to reconsider its sentence on February 7, 1997. The Defendant requests to have his sentences made concurrent. The basis for the request is the Defendant's progress since the time of incarceration as would relate to his good behavior while incarcerated and completion of many self-improvement courses and educational courses including enrollment in Westmoreland College.

The Court commends the Defendant for making the efforts for self-improvement. Such was the intent and hope of this Court, in part, in imposing the Defendant's sentence together with the Court's intent that appropriate sanctions be imposed against the Defendant.

In this Court's opinion the reasons for imposing consecutive sentences outweigh the Defendant's basis for seeking a *nunc pro tunc* reconsideration of sentence. This Court at this time has no jurisdiction to amend the sentencing Order. Accordingly, the Motion for Reconsideration is DENIED.
