

(45 additional days) to pay the appropriate sum to Mr. Flook and maintain possession of the van.

The Court has tried to allow Ms. Kane to maintain possession of this van since August 1998. Ms. Kane could have accomplished obtaining possession of the van by simply complying with a Court Order over an eight (8) month period.

In light of this history, the Court finds it difficult to now change another clearly set deadline which Ms. Kane was well aware of since she was present in the courtroom when the time frame in question was discussed and dictated into the Court Order.

For above reasons, her Motion for Reconsideration is DENIED.

This Order does not affect any claim Ms. Kane or Mr. Flook have against each other for the van or any other disputed property between the parties.

Ms. Kane shall cooperate in signing any documents needed to effectuate transfer of the van to Mr. Flook.
