## OPINION IN SUPPORT OF ORDER IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

This opinion is written in support of this court's order entered on February 26, 2024, which dismissed Appellant's Post Conviction Relief Act (PCRA) petition.

Appellant filed his notice of appeal on March 25, 2024. On April 5, 2024, the court directed Appellant to file within twenty-one days a concise statement of errors complained of on appeal. Appellant failed to file such a statement. Therefore, Appellant has waived (or failed to preserve) any issues that he wished to assert on appeal. Pa. R. A. P. 1925(b)(4)(viii)("Issues not included in the Statement and/or not raised in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph (b)(4) are waived."); see also Commonwealth v. Snyder, -- A.3d --, 2024 PA Super 97, 2024 WL 2143395 (Pa. Super. 2024)(all of the appellant's claims on appeal were waived due to his failure to file a 1925(b) statement); Commonwealth v. Baker, 311 A.3d 12, 17 (Pa. Super. 2024)("It is well settled that only issues properly raised in a timely Rule 1925(b) statement are preserved for appellate review.").

Even assuming for the sake of argument that Appellant's issues were not waived, the

court would rely on its Opinion and Order entered on January 8, 2024, a copy of which is attached for the benefit of the appellate courts.
