- ► Commonwealth vs. Creighton (04/30/2024)—Judge Nancy L. Butts Criminal: Motion to dismiss for violation of Rule 600; calculation of excludable time. (Creighton043024bt) (Posted: June 5, 2024)
- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Ruhl (04/30/2024)—Judge Ryan M. Tira Criminal: Competency determination of rape defendant; conflicting testimony of experts on whether defendant has the requisite capacity to understand the factual nature of his criminal proceedings and his ability to assist in his defense; burden of proof. (Rulh043024t) (Posted: June 5, 2024)
- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Strayer (06/03/2024)—Judge Ryan M. Tira Criminal: Defendant's motion to enforce plea agreement; cooperation with prosecution of co-defendant in return for "a plea agreement which would consider all the help and cooperation defendant was providing," authority of court to direct district attorney to negotiate in good faith; no meeting of minds on terms of agreement. Linhardt Criminal: Post-sentence motion; admissibility of prior bad acts evidence including voicemails that show motive, intent and hostility toward victim and became part of the history of the case and form part of the natural development of facts; sufficiency of evidence of risking a catastrophe where defendant crashes a vehicle into an occupied museum entranceway on a busy weekend; crashing a vehicle through the front doors of a museum constitutes criminal trespass; threatening statements made by defendant upon crashing the vehicle into the lobby of a museum sufficiently prove elements of terroristic


